

MHRB System of Care

- ▶ The Mental Health & Recovery Board has responsibility for Clark, Greene and Madison Counties.
- ▶ With a few exceptions, the services for each county are planned and funded independently.

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- ▶ The Board does not directly provide services. It contracts with partner agencies to deliver services such as outpatient and inpatient care, prevention and assistance with housing.
- ▶ The Board is legally charged to “plan, fund and evaluate”

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- ▶ **PLANNING** occurs through a process of working with consumers, providers, and other stakeholders to identify needs in the community and determine cost effective responses to the identified needs.
- ▶ Cost considerations and available funding are always taken into account.
- ▶ Appropriate providers are identified and service delivery is planned and implemented.

MHRB System of Care

- ▶ **FUNDING** is made up of a combination of federal, state and local sources.
- ▶ State funding levels are requested by state agencies and determined in the biennial budget process.
- ▶ Local funding comes from local levies and varies by county.

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- ▶ **EVALUATION** of the appropriateness and cost effectiveness of services is a key component of quality service delivery.
- ▶ Agencies use a variety of methodologies for internal evaluation of their services.
- ▶ The MHRB is implementing the Feedback in Treatment (F.I.T.) approach to providing clinical services.
